Count 1: On or about September 24, 2020 in Dubois County, State of Indiana, the following named defendant, John R. Carter, did knowingly or intentionally flee from Jesus Monarrez, a law enforcement officer, after Jesus Monarrez, by visible or audible means, including operation of his siren or emergency lights, identified himself and ordered John R. Carter to stop, and in committing said act, John R. Carter used a vehicle.

Count 2: On or about September 24, 2020 in Dubois County, State of Indiana, the following named defendant, John R. Carter, did knowingly or intentionally forcibly resist, obstruct, or interfere with Jesus Monarrez, a law enforcement officer, while Jesus Monarez was lawfully engaged in his duties as a law enforcement officer.

Count 3: On or about September 24, 2020 in Dubois County, State of Indiana, the following named defendant, John R. Carter, did operate a vehicle and recklessly drove at such an unreasonably high rate of speed under the circumstances as to endanger the safety or the property of others.

All of which is contrary to the form of the Statute in such cases made and provided against the peace and dignity of the State of Indiana.
