INITIAL HEARING

Comes now the State of Indiana, by Brian D. Lucchi, Deputy Prosecuting Attorney, and comes also the defendant, John R. Carter, in person and with an attorney, Timothy L. DeMotte, for limited purpose of initial hearing.

The Court having explained to the defendant his constitution and statutory rights, the defendant indicates he understands and has no questions concerning the same.

The Deputy Prosecuting Attorney furnishes the defendant with a written copy of the charges filed against the defendant herein, and the defendant acknowledges receipt of the charges and indicates he understands the possible penalties.

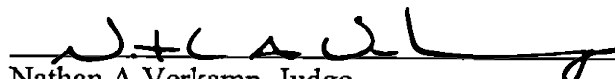
The defendant requests court appointed counsel and the Court hears testimony and now appoints Clay J. Cummins.

The Parties shall comply with Local Rules regarding discovery.

The Court now enters a preliminary plea of not guilty to this charge for the defendant and sets this matter for pre-trial conference on October 19, 2020 at 10:30 a.m.

The Court releases defendant without the requirement of posting bond to Enhanced Pretrial Monitoring through Dubois County Community Corrections. Defendant shall abstain from alcohol and illegal drugs and be subject to and pass random screens. Defendant shall obtain a mental health assessment and follow all recommendations.
