AMENDED PETITION TO REVOKE WORK RELEASE

The State of Indiana, by its Prosecuting Attorney, states that on the 19th day of April, 2023 the herein-named defendant in the above-captioned cause was ordered to **Work Release**, relevant terms of which are as follows:

1. **Violation of Community Corrections Agreement**
2. **Escape**

The State further advises that the Court's Order is still in effect and that the defendant has failed to comply with said conditions of **Work Release** as follows:

On August 14, 2023 Collin Thomas was terminated from Sonic Restaurant in Jasper. The GM of Jasper Sonic, [REDACTED], stated the reason for termination was "he was not a good fit for the company and current employees. In such a short amount of time several instances of drama occurred. As well as numerous employees concerned about things that were said to them about other employees and concern for said employees." Due to termination of employment, he violates the terms and conditions of Work Release. **PTR PENDING**

On the 08-16-2023 Collin Thomas was supposed to work at McDonalds Southside from 0330 to 1100 with a return time of 1130. He was not permitted to leave at 0330 due to him being on hold until he talked with his Case Manager [REDACTED] when she came into work. At 0800 he rang up wanting to speak with [REDACTED]. At approximately 0830 Thomas was released to go to work with [REDACTED] informing him he cannot work over and needs to return by 1130. At 1130 Collin Thomas did not return to Corrections from work. At 1200 he had not returned yet, so Officer Ryan Durcholz called Mr. Thomas' cell, and he picked up and hung up without talking. Officer Durcholz immediately called back, and Mr. Thomas' phone went directly to voicemail. Officer Durcholz tried calling his number several more times with no luck. Officer Durcholz then tried calling McDonalds where he kept getting the busy signal. At approximately 1230 Officer Durcholz tried calling Mr. Thomas again and his cell gave the busy signal; Officer Durcholz tried several other times and all he got was the busy signal. At 1300 Officer Nathan Goodnight went to McDonalds Southside and spoke with the Manager [REDACTED] and she informed him that Mr. Thomas left at 1100. At 1320 Officer Durcholz called Memorial Hospital to see if Collin Thomas was there, they informed Officer Durcholz that Mr. Collin Thomas was not there.

Mr. Collin Thomas absconded from Lawful Detention.
