SENTENCING ORDER
(Hearing held October 19, 2021)

Comes now the State of Indiana by Deputy Prosecuting Attorney, Brian D. Lucchi, and comes also the defendant, John R. Carter, in person and with counsel, Clay J. Cummins.

This case comes before the Court for sentencing on defendant's plea of guilty to Count 1, Resisting Law Enforcement, a Level 6 Felony, and defendant's admission that he is a Habitual Offender on June 22, 2021.

The Court accepted defendant's plea and admission and entered judgment of conviction on October 19, 2021.

IT IS NOW ORDERED AND ADJUDGED by the Court that the defendant, John R. Carter, is guilty of Count 1, Resisting Law Enforcement, a Level 6 Felony, and of being a habitual offender on October 19, 2021.

The Court sentences the defendant as follows:

1. The defendant shall be committed to the Indiana Department of Correction for a period of two (2) years, with credit for time served from September 25, 2020 to September 28, 2020 and good time credit.
2. The defendant's sentence is enhanced by two (2) years for being a habitual offender.

3. Therefore, defendant shall be committed to the Indiana Department of Correction for a total of four (4) years.
4. The defendant may serve the executed sentence in Dubois County Community Corrections on Home Detention with GPS Monitoring, so long as he remains eligible.
5. Counts 2 and 3 are dismissed.
